Bitches in Heat

Unless you have sanitary pants for your bitch, you will not be allowed in class.

Wear comfortable clothes and shoes. Bring all of the things on the list to each class. All lessons will start promptly at the proscribed time.

COVID Re-Opening RULES

Positive Dogs will be continually sanitizing before, during and after each class if we get another surge.
